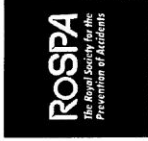

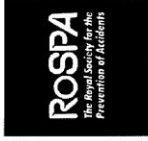
Type: Mixed Current Assessment: LOW RISK

Risk Score	Risk Categories
1-3	Very Low risk - Monitor and take action if necessary
4-7	Low risk - Monitor and take action if necessary
8-12	Medium Risk - Take action where practical to reduce risk
13-20	High Risk - Take action immediately and access control measures
21+	Unacceptable Risk - Remove or immobilise before taking remedial action

Risk Assessment Evaluation should be read in conjunction with the Annual or Post Installation Inspection report.

Risk Assessment is an ongoing process. The condition of the site should be continually monitored by the operator and measures taken to ensure that the condition of the site does not deteriorate and therefore increase the risk of the site.
